Dear Brethren,

Like you we trust in God and count on the prayers of the saints. Karen and I thank you for praying.

The 2026 school year has begun and life has gotten busy at Casa Mia. We have fifteen children so far and it is likely that a few more will be added. We desire to do better in regards to discipling the children and are making a few adjustments. Pray with us and for all the staff as we minister to the children.

There have been some changes with the church plant effort in Mosquera. One of our Mosquera co-workers moved to a pastorate leaving us a bit short handed. Then two of the three main families moved to Postrevalle. So we are currently reevaluating and praying about how to best proceed. Prayer is needed for guidance.

Classes at the Independent Baptist Institute of Discipleship are into the fourth week. God has given us nine students with whom to minister this. Several are married students and all live on campus. Among them are a Quechua family and a Guarani family. Especially pray for Brother Wilfredo (Guarani) as he and his wife, Yasendi, desire to reach their people with the Gospel, however, Wilfredo is illiterate. Karen taught his wife a literacy program that she is teaching to Wilfredo and he is progressing. Until he masters reading and writing he is doing his homework and tests orally. This is challenging. We all want to help him succeed. All the students are displaying good attitudes.

Pray with us concerning Karen's femur. God may choose to heal her without surgical intervention but He may will otherwise. There is much to consider (scheduling, ministry obligations, finances, etc.). We are praying God will show us how to proceed.
