Jamie and I are grateful for the Lord's guidance and provisions in bringing us to serve at Faith Church in Lafayette. We have been here for over three years already.

One of the special blessings of this move is being close to our parents. Sam's dad is being well cared for at a memory care facility. He is gradually getting weaker and losing kidney and lung function. He still responds positively to Sam but there is very little sign of memory otherwise. It's a privilege to pray with him and thank the Lord for His great and comforting promises. We thank Him for His presence and grace for each day as we eagerly anticipate being free from this vessel of clay and in His presence for eternity.

We live across the street from Jamie's parents who are also slowing down but thankful they are still able to live on their own. Our daily interactions with them are such a blessing.

The attendance in the Spanish Sunday service is growing little by little. It is running between 35 – 45 including the children. Please pray for Irene and the 4 boys in their late teens and early 20s that come with her. When they first came, they seemed uncomfortable and refused to share any personal information. They were our mystery guests for about a month but have continued to attend and now reflect joy and excitement to worship God and hear the preaching of the Scriptures.

Please pray for Mara and her two teenage daughters, Valery and Any Daisy. They have been attending for about 5 months. When saying goodbye, Mara often smiles and says, "I am understanding more each time!" Mara started coming because her husband is incarcerated and she was desperate for God's help.

Please pray for Dania and her 10-year-old daughter Mary. They have been attending about a year and are taking discipleship classes on Saturdays whenever we can squeeze them in.

Sam has recently had the privilege of doing two weddings. Both couples are a Hispanic and American cultural combination and both are attending our Spanish services. Eli and Allison may soon be moving to El Paso, Texas for a pastoral position for Eli. He is a recent graduate of Faith Bible Seminary. Allison has been serving with us on the worship team for more than two years. The other couple, Bruno and Cheyenne, are committed to our congregation.



Please pray for our upcoming ministry travel opportunities. We are both scheduled to teach on Biblical Counseling at a retreat center in Panama June 11-13.
